We are providing counseling and legal service support to oppressed and destitute women in the society. As on 31st March-09 we have registered 32 cases in different issues. i.e. domestic violence, family dispute, Parental property dispute etc. 23 cases are fully solved with success and other 60 cases are in the process in family court, Mahila Police Station and Orissa Mahila Commission.
